## Dutchess Community College Chemical Dependency Certificate

The **Chemical Dependency Certificate** from DCC provides an excellent foundation for the Marist Professional Studies Degree. Some of the course work completed in the certificate will assist students with the completion of Professional Studies major requirements, the Marist Core requirements and elective credits. The credits as shown on this transfer map may vary depending on the areas of study chosen within the major. Courses list below as electives may be used in the major area.

The **Professional Studies** degree is a customizable degree that allows students to choose two or three areas of study to create a 45-credit major that fits their personal goals.
